You must complete a **3 credit** practicum in your sophomore year to complete your PL Citation. The practicum gives you a chance to apply the skills and knowledge you have gained in your first year by going deeper on a specific topic or project. You can earn your 3 credits in one of the following ways:

2. A UMD study abroad trip; or
3. An internship for your major, supervised by another professor, minimum of 3 credits
